Terms and Conditions

Session Dates:

Sessions will take place every week during school the term. There will be no session during the following half-term and holidays:

February half-term- 1 session
Easter holidays- 2 sessions
May half-term- 1 session
Summer holidays- 3 sessions
October half-term- 1 session
Christmas holidays- 2 sessions

Therefore the sessions will take place for 42 weeks of the year.

Payment and Cancellation:

- •Classes are paid for monthly in advance and must be paid in full before your child attends.
- •Subsequent monthly payments will be taken on the same date each month, from the date of your initial booking (ie if you book on the 9th of the month, this will become your future billing date each month)
- •You hereby authorise Champion Pro Soccer to take automatic monthly payments. You can cancel at any time by giving a 30 day notice period.
- •It is your responsibility to ensure there are enough clear funds in your account to pay for the sessions each month. If a payment is declined you will be contacted and a manual payment will be required.
- •If classes are cancelled by Champion Pro Soccer for any reason outside our control (extreme weather/ earthquake/ government advice for extreme health and safety concerns) then no refunds will be given.
- •Other refund requests will be at the discretion of your coach .
- •All reasonable efforts will be made to refund Parents/Guardians for what is seems exceptional circumstances. We are a family run business and aim to cater for everyone where possible!
- •Parents should be aware that sessions are ongoing and to be used consecutively. No refunds will be given for missed sessions
